Electronic Devices:

Chromebooks are a required classroom supply, so bring them to school daily. Charge them every night. If you bring your charger to school, please label it clearly with your first and last name. Everyone's charger will look similar and it is your responsibility to keep track of your charger. Computers will be used when instructed, and you will stay on task until you complete the assignment. Cell phones need to be off or on silent and kept put away. If you cannot remove this distraction on your own, I will help you. Responsibility with your devices is an important life skill.

Makeup Policy:

If you are absent, please see me about your missing work when you return. One day grace will be given for each day absent. Tests need to be made up within one week of your return to help you perform your best. I will work with you to figure out a reasonable timeline for completion of makeup work, be sure you communicate with me so I can help you be successful.

Late Work and Retest Policy:

No late comprehension assignments (daily work/homework) will be accepted for full credit. If it is turned in one class day late, the grade is no higher than a 70 (30% reduction in grade). If it is two days late, the grade is no higher than a 50. After that the grade is a 0. Keep up with your classwork!

Students are permitted to submit application/project activities one day late for a 25% reduction in grade, and two days late for a 50% reduction in grade. Work is considered late if not turned in at the beginning of the student's scheduled class period or when the teacher announces the deadline for submitting work.

The teacher will provide one retest opportunity per unit test (for up to a 70%) on a date assigned by the teacher. Corrections or remediation must be done before a student retests.

Therefore, disruptive, inappropriate, unsafe, and disrespectful behaviors will not be tolerated. I will do my best to help my students learn the content and grow as young people in our community.
